Triple Cord Prayer Groups

**"...a threefold cord is not quickly broken."
Ecclesiastes 4:12b**

What is a Triple Cord Prayer Group?

Through a commitment to see God's blessing on His people and their destinies fulfilled,



Aglow women and men are uniting around the world as a Global House of Prayer.

Each group is a powerful unit within itself, as 3 link hands and hearts to go before the Lord in prayer.

The effectiveness of this prayer movement depends on establishing many individual units that interconnect around common goals. A Triple Cord Prayer Group is one of these units. Together, these groups form a vast network of prayer that can change lives, families, communities and nations.

If we are told one Christian can put a thousand to flight, and two can put ten thousand to flight (Deut 32:30), think what three can do! Further, Ecclesiastes 4:12 tells us, *Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.*



It's easier to gather 2-3 friends than it is to assemble a larger group.

How Does a Triple Cord Prayer Group Work?

Gathering in twos and threes to pray is a powerful, yet simple way for busy people to pray. By gathering in a small group on a regular basis, everyone can participate! Through Triple Cord Prayer Groups, two or three can pray at any time and place that is convenient and easily accessible.

Those who might feel uncomfortable praying aloud in a large group may find it easier in a Triple Cord Prayer Group.

You Can Form a Triple Cord Prayer Group!

1. Share with two friends about Triple Cord and invite them to form a group with you.
2. Agree on a convenient location and a time to start and close your time.
3. Share prayer requests and praise reports. Keep discussion to a minimum.
4. Allow most of your time for praying. Guard against your meeting becoming a gossip time by keeping requests confidential.
5. Pray with a focus and stay on that focus until you feel ready to move on. Make sure each member has an opportunity to pray.
6. Give thanks to the Lord for each answer to your prayers.
7. If more than three friends want to be in a Triple Cord Prayer Group, encourage them to start another group.
