Discussion Questions

- 1. Where does the mandate for the Jewish people to claim Israel as their homeland stem from?
- 2. In Genesis 12:1, God gave Abram specific instructions. What were those instructions?
- 3. Genesis 12:2-3 is a great inheritance scripture for Abram. It was God standing in Abram's future, telling him who he was to become. Name 5 of the 7 promises given to Abram in these scriptures.
- 4. Not only was Abram's immediate family to be blessed people, through Abram, this covenant made by God extends to all the people of the earth. What does this mean to you, personally?
- 5. What does the word "covenant" mean to you? How long does a covenant last with man? How long does a covenant last with God?

- 6. In ancient times, when an animal was cut in half, the 2 parties that were making an agreement would walk between the parts of the animal which signified that the terms of the agreement could not be changed. Describe how God made the covenant with Abram, not only promising to bless his descendants, but in giving Abram and his descendants the land of Israel.
- 7. God not only made the covenant with Abraham, but He reconfirmed the covenant with Isaac and with Jacob. What could be God's purpose in having a covenantal people in the earth?
